The Shire of Quairading proposes to make a local law to amend the Shire of Quairading Pest Plants Local Law 2016. The purpose of the proposed Pest Plants Amendment Local Law 2018 is to prescribe pest plants within the district. The effect of the proposed Pest Plants Amendment Local Law 2018 is that owners and occupiers of land within the district are to comply with the provisions in this local law.
