**SHIRE OF QUAIRADING**

A big thank you to everyone who completed the Shire of Quairading's Community Park Survey. These results are an important measure of our Community's views and aspirations and will provide an important role in our decision-making process. Here are some standout statistics from the survey results we would like to share with you:

- 161 people responded to the survey
- 96% of respondents were in favour of the development of a Community Park
- 73% of respondents were locals
- The top priorities for inclusions in the Park were nature play, shelter/shade, equipment for young and school aged children, ablutions and BBQ facilities
- Youth priorities were walk and bike trails, ½ court basketball and skate park.
