

KidSport Regional Pools Pilot Program Application form

The KidSport Regional Pools Pilot Program (KRPPP) is being offered by the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries to enable eligible Western Australia children aged 5 – 18 years to work on their swimming skills by offering a free season pass at selected local regional pools over the 2024 summer period, in targeted regional areas.

To support ongoing participation in community sport, eligible children may access this subsidy in addition to the existing KidSport voucher program. Applications for KidSport must be made separately via the online portal.

For new season passes only - cannot be used for a previously purchased pass.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for KidSport KRPPP the child must be:

- attending an approved regional community pool for the season; and
- aged 5 to 18 years inclusive at the time of application; and
- residing in Western Australia; and
- named on a valid Services Australia Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, with the child's unique Customer Reference Number (CRN) visible.

Application process

- 1 Check your child is eligible.
- 2 Complete this form and attach a copy of your concession card
- 3 Submit the form to your participating local government office. Once assessed and approved, you will receive a season pass from your Local Government directly.
