It also gives participant basic fire suppression techniques and strategies. All Bushfire Brigade Members MUST complete this course prior to attending an incident.

Structural Firefighting is a course recommended to brigade members looking to expand on their knowledge and skills. This course goes into structure fire behaviour, structure fire risks and safety issues, ropes and ladders, equipment and hose layouts. This course is one day theory and one day practical.

Bushfire Brigade Members who may respond to structure fires or car fires are RECOMMENDED to complete this training as it goes in detail of structural fire behaviour and safety around complex and high risk fires.
